Natural History of Pepperwood

BIO / ERTHS 85.1 (Fall) & BIO / ERTHS 85.2 (Spring)

Course Descriptions: The Santa Rosa Junior College and the Life Science and Earth and Space Science Departments are jointly offering a new course series on the natural history of Pepperwood Preserve. BIO / ERTHS 85.1 (offered Fall semester only) will emphasize earth sciences and native cultures; BIO / ERTHS 85.2 (offered Spring semester only) will emphasize the flora, fauna, and ecology. While these courses will focus on Pepperwood Preserve, the content will apply to the natural history of Sonoma County and the North Bay region. The completion of both courses is a component of the Pepperwood Preserve Steward training program and the UC Master Naturalist program.

BIO / ERTHS 85.1 – Fall semester

Dates: Classes will meet Thursday evenings and Saturdays for eight weeks, September 17–November 7.

Times and Meeting location: Thursday classes will meet 6–8 pm at the SRJC campus. Saturday classes will meet 9 am–1 pm at Pepperwood Preserve and will largely be spent in the field and involve hiking over uneven terrain.
