**Creative Re-Use** is a locally operated non-profit program that takes re-usable items- then provides them to you at miniscule cost- for your crafts, teaching, hobby, and professional artwork projects.

Those who know the program, love it. Those who don't, should. **The program helps you save \$ on a range of items from supplies, furniture, and equipment**, previously loved; and, it keeps those items out of the landfill.

As a member of this program, you receive a list of inventoried items, and a notice of the weekly hours that the store is open. The store is located near downtown Santa Rosa.

**Unfortunately, the program is likely to close its doors.**

The Sotoyome RCD - a local public agency that supports resource conservation projects- is offering to **keep it alive**. In order to do it, the agency will deliver the program a little different than before.

Two hurdles ahead are securing the necessary funds from the Sonoma County Waste Management Agency, and **getting your feedback** on the value -and your potential support- of this service.
